Urgent appeal: School Counsellors

We need your help to continue providing counsellors based in The Deanery and Byrchall High Schools. The social/emotional wellbeing of our children is under great stress and health services are overwhelmed; it takes months to get an appointment. The counsellors we provide step into this gap, providing a lifeline to hundreds of suffering children. Two thirds of those who've received help from our counsellors report improved wellbeing. Yet the impact is even greater: school staff are strengthened and peer support groups have been set up to help those who live with anger issues, self harm and eating disorders.

Despite all this, it is becoming harder to get grants from funders. We have a solid base of funds but need your generosity to safeguard this crucial ministry into the future. Here's how you can make a difference:

- £25 funds one counselling session
- £100 covers a month of support for one student
- £500 will support one student for an entire term
